Provisional distribution Activism grants 2021 ABC committee



The ABC has received all applications for FOBOS grants from the boards of the study associations. The committee has evaluated the applications according to the OS FOBOS Model (OSFM) and has worked on approving as many applications as possible. This succeeded in many cases but not in all. Some applications have been rejected because boards have failed to provide the necessary information or the application was not in line with the OSFM or FOBOS rules in general. The OS Board will use the division in this document for the negotiations with other umbrellas, in line with the procedure laid out in the OSFM.

Although most requested have been included in the provisional distribution, the ABC has also declined some requests. The larger associations received board grants under a separate category within FOBOS. For the smaller associations, grants are requested under E&I.

Boards Extra

For every month a full-time board has more than five board members, they are eligible for one extra grant. Some associations have only had six or more board members for a part of the year, so they only receive extra grants for those months. Part-time boards only receive 7 grants for a full year, which has been taken into account in calculating their extra board grants.

Should

The requests for after Kick-In activities were originally, in line with the OS FOBOS Model, placed under Must. However, in consultation with the E&I meeting, it was decided that these kinds of requests are not of the same importance as normal Kick-In requests. Kick-In committees are deemed important because of their fundamental role in not only profiling the association, but also assisting new students in starting their studies. Furthermore, due to the dependence of the faculties, study programmes and the central Kick-In organization on the so-called OKICs, those kinds of activities are put in Must. As these arguments do not hold for after Kick-In activities, these have been moved to Should, in line with after Kick-In activities of student associations. The ABC aims to change the OSFM to reflect this change in due course.
