



The ABC has requested proof for all applications for FOBOS grants from the boards of the study associations. The committee has evaluated the proofs according to the OS FOBOS Model (OSFM) and has worked on approving as many applications as possible. This succeeded in many cases but not in all. Some applications have been rejected because boards have failed to provide the necessary proofs or the application was not in line with the OSFM or FOBOS rules in general.

The distribution of grants in this document is an approximation of the actual numbers that will be processed by the E&I meeting and the Student Union to provide FOBOS to the approved boards/activities. Please note that some activities have addressed an increased number of hours in their proofs with respect to their application. If the ABC believes this increase to be reasonable and substantiated, the additional hours and grants can be found between brackets. OS will try to obtain the extra grants for those hours, however, no rights can be derived from the approximations of them in this document.

## **Boards**

The larger associations received board grants under a separate category within FOBOS. For the smaller associations, grants are requested under E&I.

## Must

In line with the corona regulations that were already in place for grants of calendar year 2020, some exceptions are also in place for 2021. This means several activities that had already been requested for 2020 but were postponed were requested again for 2021. Furthermore, Kick-In committees have been included in the Must category for the first time this year. Some associations delivered more hours in their proofs than they originally requested. Based on the reasoning behind this increase that the association provided and the agreements within the E&I meetings of the SU, the ABC decided to take these new requests, with a higher amount of hours, to the E&I meeting or not. The requests for which this is the case are marked with an hour amount between brackets. This is no guarantee that the other umbrella's will agree, but the OS Board will try to convince them. For the rest of the requests, the amount of hours of the first requests is taken as maximum.

## Boards Extra

For every month a full-time board has more than five board members, they are eligible for one extra grant. Some associations have only had six or more board members for a part of the year, so they only receive extra grants for those months. Part-time boards only receive 7 grants per person for a full year, which has been taken into account in calculating their extra board grants.
