Distribution Activism grants 2022
ABC committee



The ABC received all proofs for FOBOS grants from the boards of the study associations. The committee evaluated the proofs according to the OS FOBOS Model (OSFM) and worked on approving as many proofs as possible. This succeeded in many cases but not in all. Some proofs have been rejected because boards have failed to provide the necessary information or the proof was not in line with the OSFM or FOBOS rules in general.

The OS Board will use the division in this document for the negotiations with other umbrellas, in line with the procedure laid out in the OSFM. Note that this means this division is not final yet.

The ABC did notice that a lot of similar mistakes were made in the applications therefore, the ABC wants to stress the following rules that were introduced this year again:

- A workweek for a committee cannot be any longer than 40 hours.
- A Europe trip committee and a Study Tour committee can make at most 25 hours per committee member per week during the trip. This is calculated as follows: “During the weekend we count 5 hours per committee member per day and on every workday we count 3 hours per committee member per day.”
- Continuous committees cannot be active for more than 48 weeks.

Although most proofs have been included in the provisional distribution, the ABC has also declined some proofs. An overview of these rejections and the reasons for rejection can be found in Table 6. The larger associations received board grants under a separate category within FOBOS. For the smaller associations, grants are requested under E&I.

Boards Extra

For every month a full-time board has more than five board members, they are eligible for one extra grant. Some associations have only had six or more board members for a part of the year, so they only receive extra grants for those months. Part-time boards only receive 7 grants for a full year, which has been taken into account in calculating their extra board grants.
