

Revised Membership Fee Agreement

The membership fee, as mentioned in this document, is the amount of money the members of the associations affiliated with the Organisation of Study associations pay to be a member of the study association. In order to keep the costs for a membership in the same magnitude of money for everyone, these amounts and periods are agreed upon during the OS GMA. These agreements work as a guideline for associations to set a membership fee. During the GMA on February 26th, 2025, the following agreements were made.

- A primary member pays between €8.50 and €15 per year to be a member of their association.
- A secondary member pays between €4.25 and €7.50 per year to be a member of their association.
- A lifelong membership can be offered for three times the primary membership fee, since that is the nominal study period, thus being between €25.50 and €45.

Associations can choose to offer different time periods and these should comply with the prices mentioned above. For example, half a year for a primary member can be offered for a price between €4.25 and €7.50.
