## **Committees**

## Activism Grants Committee (ABC)

The ABC has checked all documents for the request cycle and the updated hours count has been finalised. An evaluation meeting was held, and OSFM updates were discussed. Last meeting was the shortest of all, with almost no topics to discuss. The meeting before that, we had a guest speaker opening up the discussion about AI usage at the university. Having a guest speaker was very interesting.

## Coordination group KIC

We are in contact with the Kick-In Committee and have bi-monthly meetings with them to keep up-to-date.

#### **ERO**

There is still no update on the ERO division for the upcoming year, as discussed during the previous GMA, but the OS board is keeping a close eye on any developments.

# External Affairs Assembly (EB)

Due to several reasons, the meetings of February and March were cancelled, and the April meeting did not have a high attendance. However, OS talked to the chair of the Assembly, and together, we came up with a plan to improve the attendance for the next meetings.

# FocOS Groups

We have now had three FocOS meetings on different topics, for which the attendance has been satisfactory.

#### ICT/Boardsite

We are currently working on updating the website. Key changes will be updated descriptions of the committees and responsibilities, a clear overview of which OS board member is responsible for what and how to contact them, and a centralised page for agreements.

#### L.P.S.V. Exedra

There have now been two meetings which have been quite informative. Last meeting, topics like social safety and wellbeing were discussed. The current goal of Exedra is to define the vision and convert this to a plan for the upcoming years to safeguard the development and guarantee a successful new umbrella organization.

#### **MentOS**

We switched the format of the MentOS meetings, which are now more brainstorm-focused. This was received very well by most board members and the meetings have been useful.

## OS Cup

This year's OS Cup is nearly done, the final assignments and subsequent winner announcement will be announced at the upcoming After-GMA Drink.

#### **PenOS**

The PenOS (Treasurer Assembly) has been formed and made a responsibility of OS. There has now been one meeting.

#### Social Media

Since the start of this academic year, there has been an increase of 10% in followers on Instagram. As mentioned in the mid-year report, we have decided to continue with the association takeover, based on **requests** of the associations, rather than OS trying to plan them. There were no pictures taken at the previous CoBo, so unfortunately we couldn't post that. We will continue posting when necessary / interesting / fun, rather than following a strict promotion planning.

#### Student news

The OS board is present at the meetings dedicated to deciding the contents of the Student News e-mails all students get. The OS board recognises that the current state is less than ideal and is working together with M&C to see if it can be improved such that it is read more.
