

The Activism Grants Committee (ABC) received the requests for FOBOS grants from the boards of the study associations for the calendar year 2025. The committee evaluated these requests according to the OS FOBOS Model (OSFM). In this document, one can find the results of this evaluation.

The OS Board will use the division in this document for the negotiations with other umbrellas, in line with the procedure laid out in the OSFM. Note that the divisions voted upon in the OS General Members Assembly (GMA) are always subject to changes made in the meetings with the other umbrellas and the Student Union.

Last Proofs phase (October 2024), a new rule was set in place that committees over 1000 hours should provide a generalised overview of the tasks of the committee and the time these tasks take. For this Requests phase we also asked for this logbook besides the usual substantiation for these requests.

However, when reviewing the requests there were many cases where there were little to no substantiations for the requests. Combined with the low number of members in the ABC, this caused some timing and communication issues. In the end, all requests and substantiations could be reviewed, but the ABC will discuss these issues in an evaluation meeting.
